From **2027 to 2032, one Tamworth High School HSC graduate each year** will receive a BCEF–Blume Family CSU Scholarship.

Scholarship Value

- Up to \$40,000
- Paid as \$10,000 per year for up to four years
- Pro rata for shorter degree courses

Eligibility

- Complete their **HSC at Tamworth High School in 2026-2031**
- Commence their **first year of undergraduate study at CSU in 2027**
- Demonstrate:
 - Academic commitment
 - Leadership or initiative
 - Community and/or extracurricular involvement
 - Financial need

Preference may be given to students whose studies support future contribution to rural and regional communities.
